### Structured Dialogue on Agriculture" - starting in a rush!



When EU Commission President Dr. **Ursula von der Leyen** voiced the idea of a "structured dialogue on agriculture" in her State of the Union speech in September 2023, the official accompanying video showed milk processing. On January 18, 2024, 125 days after the State of the Union announcement, the EU Commission did send out invitations for a kick-off plenary meeting on January 25, 2024.

Today's farmers' protests in quite a few Member States may have hastened the process of setting up this 'strategic dialogue on agriculture' format, but the invitation list, with a wide range of NGOs and only a few EU umbrella organizations of the food chain, i.e., the farming sector and their processors, would have certainly deserved a more thoughtful approach. As important a dialogue on the future of agriculture is, as urgent is a constructive discussion on adressing today's concerns of the agri-food community.

We have shared our preliminary input in writing with EU Commission Vice President Maroš Šefčovič, who clearly underlined his intention to reach out to economic stakeholders and expressed his hope to be able to count on our continued dairy engagement.

## MIV Dairy Meetings at the Green Week in Berlin

The President of our German member association Milchindustrie-Verband e.V., (MIV), **Peter Stahl** (CEO, Hochland) welcomed the 'crème de la crème' of the German dairy industry in the Bavarian embassy in Berlin for a podium discussion on: "Who decides on our food: The citizen or politics?"

The very vivid discussion between dairy experts like Michael Müller (Andechser Molkerei Scheitz) and Dr. Katrin Lehmann (MIV) and the President of the Federal Office for Agriculture and Food (BLE), Dr. Margareta Büning-Fesel also touched on the different basic concepts of citizens responsibility underlaying the food labelling approaches, especially when it comes to the nutri-score.

### CDG Milk: EDA and Friesland-Campina highlight the sustainability efforts in dairy

Last week, the EU Commission organized its meeting of the Civil Dialogue Group on Milk, a consultative group aimed at exchanging views with stakeholders along the dairy value chain.



Sustainability in dairy was one of the highlights of the meeting, emphasizing the environmental efforts implemented by dairy companies in Europe and the proactive approach of the industry in climate action.

Sanne Dekker, co-chair of the EDA Working Group on sustainability, highlighted FrieslandCampina's actions toward reducing greenhouse gas emissions. Alberto Babolin, EDA, stressed the importance of the Dairy Product Environmental Footprint (Dairy PEF) methodology—the harmonized method for assessing the environmental footprint of dairy products in Europe. This methodology, developed by the dairy industry, is crucial in the context of the Green Claims discussions. The Dairy PEF is a Life Cycle Assessment (LCA) methodology approved by the EU Commission and Member States in 2018, now defined as the reference methodology for environmental footprint assessment in dairy.
